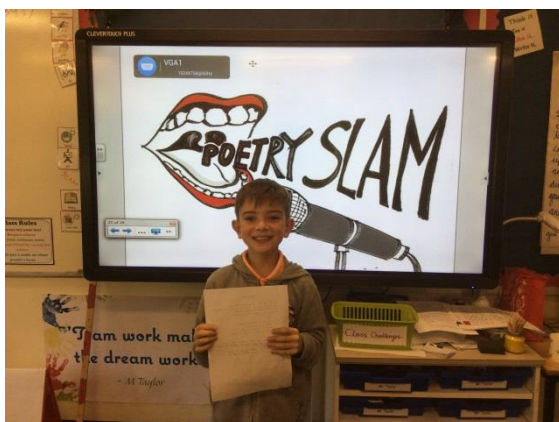
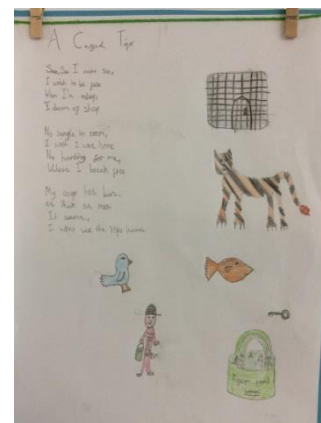
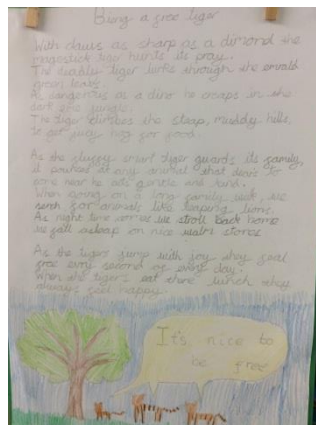
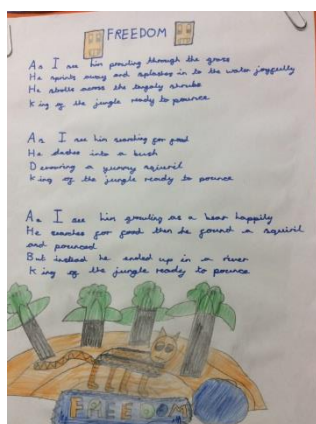
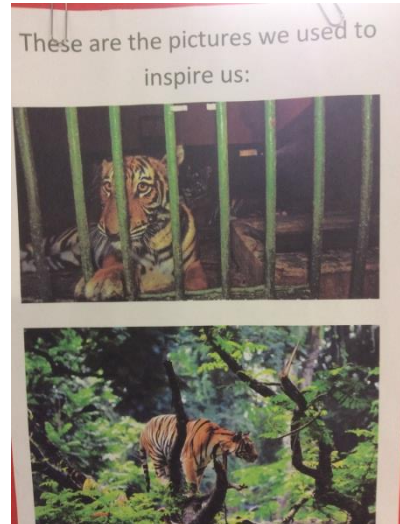


A week in Year 4 - Term 1
