

English We will be continuing to develop the children's story writing by looking at a range of space adventures and fantasy stories. We will be writing recounts using adjectives and time words. The children will learn to write explanations using pictures to show a process supported by sentences and build on their research skills by writing reports, creating non-fiction books about sea creatures. There will continue to be an emphasis on the consistent use of punctuation.

Science The children will continue to observe the changes that happen within different seasons. We will also be using the school grounds to help the children in identifying common plants and trees. This will include looking at the basic structure of both plants and trees. The children will have the opportunity to plant seeds. The children will also learn about everyday materials and their properties.

Geography

Our geography will focus on the key features of a beach, cliff and coastal regions and the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles.

Art

The children will create a solar system picture using oil pastels. The children will have the opportunity to explore texture to create a seascape or landscape picture .

DT

The children will develop an understanding of simple mechanisms through designing and making moving pictures. These will be based around our Space topic. Children develop their understanding of how movement can be created using simple levers and sliders.

PSHE

We will return to themes already covered in our nurturing sessions. The children will have the opportunity to share their feelings and opinions and engage in role play. The children will become equipped with skills to enable them to engage with others successfully.

Mathematics

We will be building upon the children's knowledge on number, place value, addition, subtraction and place value by solving problems and using manipulatives. The children will also explore weight and capacity. We will continue to develop the children's learning of money.

History

We will be exploring space, the solar system and looking at famous astronauts and significant events in space travel. The children will be finding out about the seaside today and in the past .



PE

We will explore dance, responding to music combining movements for effect and outdoor adventure activities.

Music

The children will explore the inter-related dimensions of music such as - pitch, tempo, melody, timbre, rhythm, texture by listening to various pieces of music and exploring some percussion instruments.

RE

We will be studying Judaism, looking at the festivals, special symbols and practices of Jewish people. The children will also learn the story of The 10 Lepers.

Computing

In Term 5 the children will create a talking book based on a story explored in English. In Term 6 they will have the opportunity to program a bee bot to follow simple instructions along a bee bot mat created in DT.
