#### Historical Detective

This term we are learning about the Romans. What would a Roman man or woman have looked like? Research the types of clothes that would have been worn by Romans and find out what materials they would have been made from. What tools and items might they have carried around with them? Did everybody wear the same thing? How different were women's clothes to men's? Would all men/women look the same? **Draw a picture** of a Roman and label what clothes they would have worn and what tools they would have carried around with them. Try to explain how the clothes were made and what the tools were used for. You might also like to design and create your own **model Roman clothes** for a doll or paper person.



Your compulsory home learning will be set on: *Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> March, Friday 9<sup>th</sup> March* and *Friday 16<sup>th</sup> March*. All children are expected to complete and return this homework by the following Wednesday.
