

Geography - Climate Zones

Choose a climate zone discussed in class and find out more. Try to find features that are unusual or interest you. For example: what creatures (including people) exist in different zones? Find out if there are any specially adapted creatures (like the little beetles that collect moisture from the night-time mist in the desert) and explain in a diagram or piece of illustrated writing, how they are adapted. Draw a chart, picture or diagram that makes a comparison between the features of different climates. Choose geographical aspects to compare, like rainfall, hours of daylight or temperatures.

RE - Hindu Gods

Next in RE, we will be learning about Hinduism. Hindu people worship lots of different Gods. Can you find out about one of the Hindu Gods and create a fact file or a poster about them? Perhaps, if you don't fancy that, you could choose something else to research about Hinduism - whatever takes your fancy! You can present your work in any way you like.



Photography and Art


Our overriding theme for the next couple of terms is 'The Natural World'.
