On Tuesday 20th September, Year 3 had a great day with Clive and Annie. The day started with finding out about different types of animals and classification. We learnt about vertebrates and invertebrates. Then we learnt about mammals, amphibians, reptiles, fish and birds. The most fantastic part was seeing the creatures and getting to hold some of them! We also discovered acorns, blackberries, different kinds of berries and flowers. We know that butterflies like the nectar from flowers and the that birds eat all of the berries.

Before lunch we looked at a range of bird beaks and practised picking different food items up. Some things were trickier than others. After lunch, Annie taught us how to make our very own bird head and beak with clay. We made a miniature head first and then made a larger version later. It was great.
