



Think about Rules

Imagine you are the first person on an imaginary island. As other people come to join you on 'your' island you find that you need to develop some rules for living together as one big community.

What rules will you need to all be healthy, happy and safe?

Have a discussion with a member of your family and then prepare to present your chosen rules to the class. Perhaps you might scribe them on a scroll, or write them onto a plasticine or tablet. Find a fun way of recording them for others to read.

Tell a story without words

Imagine that you are living in 12000BC and Britain is beginning to warm after the Ice Age. You live a hunter/gatherer life, hunting mammals such as reindeer. Choose a member of your family to be the 'messenger' - they will share a message by drawing a picture. Try to guess the message/story. For example: I've had a successful hunt today and killed a deer OR I've found a new cave that we can shelter in to keep dry.
